In the qathet region, **Evolugen** by Brookfield Renewable operates high-Voltage transmission lines that carry the electricity between our Lois and Townsite generating facilities. Our transmission corridor crosses through Townsite, behind the complex and hospital and across Padget Road through to Stillwater. If you live near the line or travel within the corridor, read this brochure to **ensure your safety**.

TRANSMISSION LINES

Public Safety

- Transmission lines are common in our communities and are designed and constructed with Public Safety in mind.
- Common Sense and awareness can prevent accidents.
- The protection of people is our number one priority.
- Electricity can jump and often does when a potential conductor like metal, trees and people come too close to Power lines.
- Electricity is all around electrical wires. This means even if you get too close to electrical line the energy will hurt you.



Top rules for safety near transmission lines

- Obey all signs and don't trespass.
- Don't climb transmission towers or any other electrical equipment.
- Don't climb trees or vegetation near transmission lines.
- Don't fly kites, drones or other toys in near transmission lines.
- Don't construct or raise any structures or poles near the Transmission line.
- Stay away and report unsafe conditions such as downed lines, trees that have fallen onto lines, or damaged structures.



Getting too close to dams is dangerous.

There are currents and fast moving water above and below dams.

Signs, fences, buoys, and safety booms are there to protect you and warn you of the hazards.



DAMS

Common hazards around dams

- Strong currents and undertows
- Falling
- Tripping
- Equipment
- Changes in flows and water levels



Top rules for safety near dams

- Obey all signs, fences, booms, buoys and barriers at dams and along the shorelines.
- Stay back from the edge of the water near dams. If you see water levels changing, move away from the water.
- Do not swim near dams or in areas with strong currents.
- Never stand, fish or boat below a dam. Water levels can change quickly.
- Never paddle near dams.
- Don't wade into moving water.
- If you hear sirens near the dam move back. It is a warning conditions/water levels are about to change.
